#### Monitors

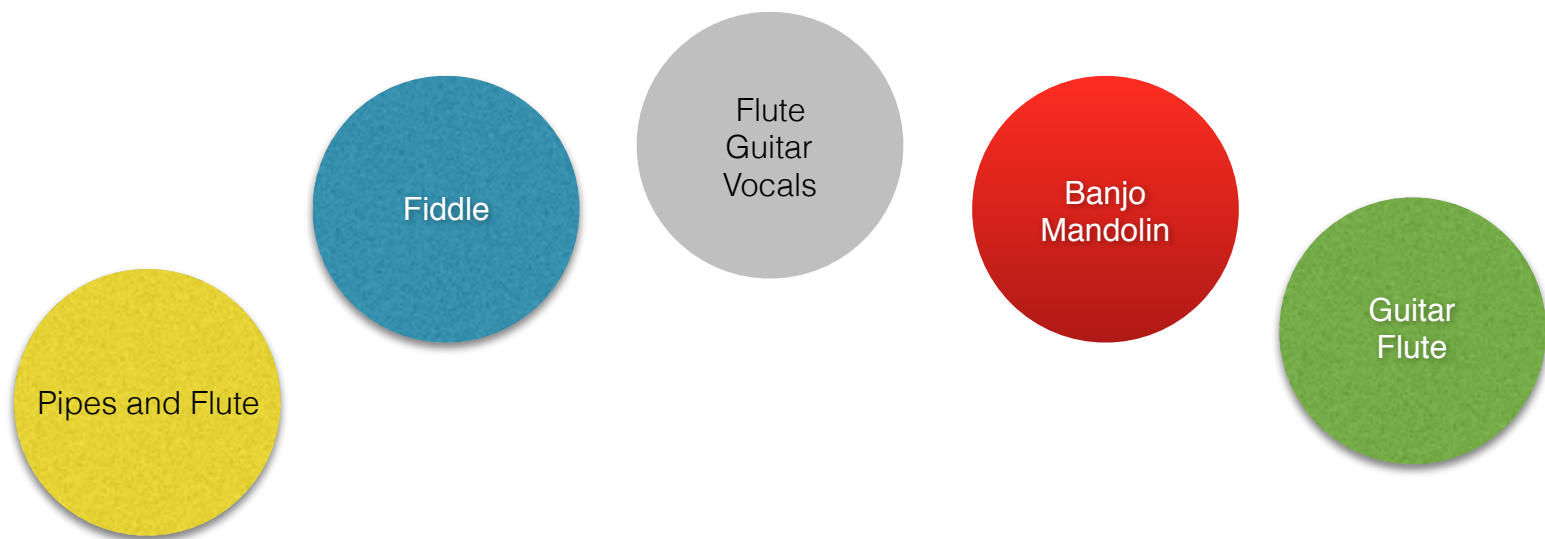
